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Following the success of her previous film "Spicy Calabria" (which won 12 international festival awards and is currently distributed in Italy, the UK, the USA, Germany, and Japan), which explored the world's spiciest region to uncover the world of chili peppers, Esmeralda Spadea embarks on a journey through various Italian regions to discover wines produced by celebrities from the sports, film, music, and art worlds. This film offers a unique way to tell the stories of these stars, starting from a shared passion and taking viewers on an unprecedented journey filled with taste and legendary anecdotes from internationally renowned personalities.

On screen, you'll see **Al Bano**, who shares from the heart of Puglia how his career as a world-renowned singer intertwines with his passion for wine, emphasizing the importance of roots, passion, and sacrifice. **GianMarco Tognazzi** who, in the Free Territory of La Tognazza near Rome, produces "very oeno and little logical" wines, true wines of memory that take you back to the past of affections, family, and childhood. In Abruzzo, **Jarno Trulli** who blends the slow pace of vine cultivation with the lightning-fast world of Formula 1 racing. From Il Palagio among the Tuscan hills, **Trudie Styler** and winemaker **Riccardo Cotarella** craft their bottled messages, blending timeless songs, cinematic tales, and wines rich with stories. Brazilian soccer player **Anderson Hernanes** produces wines in Monferrato at Ca' Del Profeta, with labels inspired by Biblical passages, while in Canavese, **Johnson Righeira** celebrates creative freedom. Driven by their love for Romagna, **Carlo Cracco** and his wife **Rosa Fanti**, a native of Santarcangelo, have revived a native vine once thought lost. Lastly, under the Puglian sun reminiscent of Californian landscapes, **Ronn Moss** sings his songs among the vineyards, celebrating a career of continued success fueled by his love for Italy.

SYNOPSIS

Esmeralda Spadea travels through Italy to discover the wines of the stars. This exploration of Italian winemaking culture is told through the stories of celebrities who have chosen to produce wine in our regions. In Tuscany, we find Trudie Styler producing wine with her husband Sting, in Lazio Gianmarco Tognazzi, in Piedmont Johnson Righeira and Anderson Hernanes, in Puglia Al Bano and Ronn Moss, in Abruzzo Jarno Trulli, in Romagna Carlo Cracco and Rosa Fanti, and many more. Through entertaining anecdotes and touching memories associated with wine, we discover an unusual side of both the stars and our country.
